Common Names: Goldfish Plant,
Candycorn Plant

Family: Gesneriaceae

Origin: Brazil

Growth: Trailing vine

Light: Bright, indirect

Foot Candles: 175 - 225

Water: Allow to partially dry

Humidity: Not required.

Temperature: 18°C - 26°C

Soil: Regular potting mix

Container: Hanging basket, tabletop

Nutrients: 10-15-10 Spring & Summer

Propagation: Seed, cuttings

Interiorscape Use: Hang in windows, living walls, filler plant



Common Pests: Mealybugs, Aphids, Spider Mites, Scale, Thrips.

Common Issues: Root rot when over-watered. Chemicals may scorch the leaves. Try to avoid watering the leaves as that may induce scorching.

Comments: A green vining plant with adorable orange flowers that resemble goldfish. Easy to propagate and can tolerate some neglect.

Toxicity: Safe.
