Common Names: Pink Blush Aloe

Family: Aloeaceae

Origin: South Africa

Growth: Clumping

Light: Full sun

Foot Candles: 250+

Water: When completely dry

Humidity: Not required

Temperature: 18°C+

Soil: Cactus mix

Container: Wide planter with drainage

Nutrients: 10-5-5 Monthly in Spring & Summer

Propagation: Seed or removal of offsets

Interiorscape Use: Desktop, Desert-themed atrium



Common Pests: Mealybugs, Aphids, Spider Mites, Scale, Thrips.

Common Issues: Root rot when overwatered. Leaves may break inside causing a drooping look.

Comments: Very interesting looking Aloe plant. Perfect for succulent collectors! An artistically coloured cultivar with soft colours and a pink hue.

Toxicity: Safe.
