

# Breynia disticha

BRAY-nee-uh DIS-tik-uh

**Common Names:** Snow Bush, Snow-On-The-Mountain, Sweet Pea Bush

**Family:** Phyllanthaceae

**Origin:** New Caledonia and Vanuatu

**Growth:** Bushy

**Light:** Bright, filtered

**Foot Candles:** 100 - 200

**Water:** Let surface dry slightly between watering

**Humidity:** 25% - 60%

**Temperature:** 13°C - 25°C

**Soil:** Regular potting mix

**Container:** Self-watering planter, desktop, living wall

**Nutrients:** 10-10-10 Monthly

**Propagation:** Stem tip cuttings

**Interiorscape Use:** Desktop, living walls

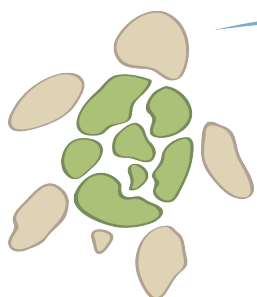


**Common Pests:** Mealybugs, Aphids, Spider Mites, Scale, Thrips.

**Common Issues:** Root rot when sitting in water. Leaves will crisp with too much light. Salt in soil or water will quickly scorch the plant.

**Comments:** To prevent the plant from becoming leggy and sprawling, pinch back the long growth to promote a bushier look. This will also help maintain the overall colour of the plant.

**Toxicity:** Safe.
