RAY-pis ek-SEL-suh

Common Names: Lady Palm,
Finger Palm, Bamboo Palm

Family: Arecaceae

Origin: China, Vietnam

Growth: Upwards, clumping

Light: Low - medium

Foot Candles: 75 - 200

Water: Keep evenly moist

Humidity: 30% - 70%

Temperature: 18°C - 30°C

Soil: Well draining potting mix

Container: Self-watering planter

Nutrients: 15-10-10 Monthly

Propagation: Seed, division

Interiorscape Use: Large potted plant in shaded area,
atrium, covered patio



Common Pests: Mealybugs, Aphids, Spider Mites,
Scale, Thrips.

Common Issues: Root rot when overwatered, leaf scorch in direct sunlight.

Comments: It is one of the most popular palms for indoor environments because it can tolerate lower light conditions than most palms and survive a decent amount of neglect.

Toxicity: Safe.
